1. Overview

The European Academy of Religion (EuARe) 2026 Organizing Committee is pleased to announce the call for 5 travel grants financed by the *Österreichisches Historisches Institut Rom* to support the participation of young students and researchers for the upcoming ninth annual EuARe Conference.

2. Eligibility

To participate in the present call for travel grants, applicants must:

- a. Be resident in Austria at the time of application for the grant;
- b. Be an active student and/or early-career researcher;
- c. Be a member of the European Academy of Religion in 2026;
- d. Attend the European Academy of Religion 2026 in Luiss, Rome.

3. Grant Coverage

The present travel grant is intended to cover:

- a. Transportation costs (for a maximum of 250 euros).
- b. Accommodation in the residence of the *Österreichisches Historisches Institut Rom* (Viale Bruno Buozzi 111-113, I-00197 Roma).

Travel reimbursements will be made after submission of original receipts and proof of attendance. Grant recipients are expected to observe the house rules and regulations of the *Österreichisches Historisches Institut Rom*.
